MUHC Challenge Q+

In 2012, the MUHC initiated an annual competition, the Challenge Q+, as an initiative to promote and reward innovative ideas for Quality Improvement. Each year proposals submitted by the various faculties and departments of the MUHC are appraised by a panel of healthcare professionals and patient representatives for their innovation, sustainability and patient involvement. The winner of this competition is rewarded with a grant of \$150,000 to design and run the initiative outlined in their proposal.

In February of 2016, it was announced that the proposal for the Recovery Transition Program had been selected as the Winner by the Challenge Q+ Panel.
